What is the Canada Ontario Job Grant?

The Canada Ontario Job Grant is a partnership between the federal and provincial governments to fund employer-driven training initiatives. The grant provides direct financial support for employers to purchase training for their workforce. The cost of training is a shared investment between the employer and the federal and provincial government.

How much funding can an employer receive from the Canada Ontario Job Grant?

The Canada Ontario Job Grant supports eligible training costs up to a maximum of \$10,000 per participant.



Who is eligible for the Canada Ontario Job Grant?

Employers in Ontario that identify training need in their organization.

What are eligible training costs?

Eligible training costs may include tuition, textbooks, tools and equipment.

Is there a limit on the duration of a training program?

Training must not exceed one year.

Who can provide the training?

Training can be provided by a College of Applied Arts and Technology, publicly assisted university, school board, private trainer, union-based training centre, and product vendors with manufacturer-recognized training certifications.
